Crime of the Production and Operation of Harmful Food

Production or operation of the food listed below that are hazardous to human health constitutes a crime and is subject to a maximum penalty of five years' imprisonment or 600 days' fine:

1. Food incorporated with non-food raw materials or chemical substances other than food additives;
2. Food subject to misuse of food additives;
3. Food that contains waste or expired food as raw materials;
4. Food that contains pathogenic microorganisms, pesticide residues, veterinary drug residues, heavy metals, radioactive substances, or other substances harmful to human health;
5. Food that contains the meat of animals that died of diseases or died from poison or unknown causes, parts of such animals or products made from such animals;
6. Food that contains uninspected substances that are legally subject to inspection or those that have failed inspection;
7. Food that has been adulterated, spoiled or deteriorated;
8. Food with reduced nutritional value due to the removal of a certain ingredient or element.
