

Administrative Violations

Production or operation of the food listed below constitutes an administrative violation and is subject to a fine of MOP 50,000 to MOP 600,000 even without actual harm to individuals' health:

- 1.Food incorporated with non-food raw materials or chemical substances other than food additives;
- 2. Food that contains waste or expired food as raw materials;
- 3. Food that contains the meat of animals that died of diseases or died from poison or unknown causes, parts of such animals or products made from such animals;
- 4. Food that contains uninspected substances that are legally subject to inspection or those that have failed inspection;
- 5. Food that has been adulterated, spoiled or deteriorated;
- 6. Food that fails to meet food safety standards.
